# A History of Growth, Division, and Collaboration

- Phase I: 1992 2002: C.A. in Alberta is born
  - August 1995: C.A. Alberta is recognized as an official Area at the World Service Conference
  - August 2002: Northern Alberta Area ratified at WSC
- Phase II: 2002 2010: Southern Alberta takes shape
  - <u>July 2005</u>: Alberta Area submits request to WSC to disband the Alberta Area and ratify the Southern Alberta Area
- Phase III: 2011 2020: Growth and Evolution
  - From approx. 10 meetings to >30 meetings







- Audio files can then be converted to video files and uploaded to an unlisted YouTube channel.







