

HUMAN BEING THE EXACT NATURE OF OUR WRONGS. 6. WERE ENTIRELY READY TO HAVE GOD REMOVE ALL THESE DEFECTS OF CHARACTER. 7. HUMBLY ASKED HIM TO REMOVE OUR SHORTCOMINGS. 8. MADE A LIST OF ALL PERSONS WE HAD HARMED, AND BECAME WILLING TO MAKE AMENDS TO THEM ALL. 9. MADE DIRECT AMENDS TO SUCH PEOPLE WHEREVER POSSIBLE, EXCEPT WHEN TO DO SO WOULD INJURE THEM WHEN WE WERE WRONG PROMPTLY ADMITTED IT. 11. FOR OUR GROUP PURPOSE THERE IS BUT ONE ULTIMATE **AUTHORITY — A LOVING GOD AS HE MAY EXPRESS** HIMSELF IN OUR GROUP CONSCIENCE, OUR LEADERS ARE BUT TRUSTED SERVANTS; THEY DO NOT GOVERN. 3. THE ONLY REQUIREMENT FOR C.A. MEMBERSHIP IS A DESIRE TO STOP USING COCAINE AND ALL OTHER MIND-4. EACH GROUP SHOULD BE AUTONOMOUS EXCEPT IN MATTERS AFFECTING OTHER GROUPS OR C.A. AS A WHOLE. 5. EACH GROUP HAS BUT ONE PRIMARY PURPOSE — TO CARRY ITS MESSAGE TO THE ADDICT WHO STILL SUFFERS. 6. A C.A. GROUP OUGHT NEVER ENDORSE, FINANCE, OR LEND THE C.A. NAME TO ANY RELATED FACILITY OR **OUTSIDE ENTERPRISE, LEST PROBLEMS OF MONEY,** SUPPORTING, DECLINING OUTSIDE CONTRIBUTIONS. 8. COCAINE ANONYMOUS SHOULD REMAIN FOREVER NONPROFESSIONAL, BUT OUR SERVICE CENTERS MAY **EMPLOY SPECIAL WORKERS.** 9. C.A., AS SUCH, OUGHT NEVER BE ORGANIZED; BUT WE MAY CREATE SERVICE BOARDS OR COMMITTEES DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE TO THOSE THEY SERVE. 10. COCAINE ANONYMOUS HAS NO OPINION ON OUTSIDE ISSUES; HENCE THE C.A. NAME OUGHT NEVER BE DRAWN 11. OUR PUBLIC RELATIONS POLICY IS BASED ON ATTRACTION RATHER THAN PROMOTION: WE NEED ALWAYS MAINTAIN PERSONAL ANONYMITY AT THE LEVEL OF PRESS, RADIO, TELEVISION AND FILMS. 12. ANONYMITY IS THE SPIRITUAL FOUNDATION OF ALL **OUR TRADITIONS, EVER REMINDING US TO PLACE** PRINCIPLES BEFORE PERSONALITIES.
